ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The American Rescue Plan (ARP) provided over a \$1.9 trillion in relief to address the impact of Covid-19 pandemic on the economy. From the ARP, \$5 billion was allocated for the Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) Program.

The Housing Authority of the County of Monterey received 240 EHV's for Monterey County and 29 EHV's for San Benito County from the U.S., Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Coalition of Homeless Service Providers and partnering agencies will provide applications and direct referrals for the EHV program after August 4th, 2021.

Eligibility will be limited to individuals and families who are:

1. Homeless;
2. At-risk of homelessness;
3. Fleeing or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking; and
4. Recently homeless and for whom providing rental assistance will prevent the family's homelessness of having a high risk of housing instability.

SOBRE EL PROGRAMA

El American Rescue Plan (ARP) proporcionó más de \$ 1.9 billones en ayuda para abordar el impacto de la pandemia de Covid-19 en la economía. Del ARP, se asignaron \$ 5 mil millones para el programa de Vales de Vivienda de Emergencia (VVE).

La Autoridad de Vivienda del Condado de Monterey recibió 240 VVE para el condado de Monterey y 29 VVE para el condado de San Benito del Departamento de Vivienda y Desarrollo Urbano de EE. UU.

La Coalición de Proveedores de Servicios para Personas sin Hogar y las agencias asociadas proporcionarán solicitudes y referencias directas para el programa VVE después del 4 de agosto de 2021.

La elegibilidad se limitará a las personas y familias que:

1. Sin hogar;
2. En riesgo de quedarse sin hogar;
3. Huir o intentar huir, violencia doméstica, violencia en el noviazgo, agresión sexual, acoso o trata de personas; y
4. Recientemente sin hogar y para quienes proporcionar asistencia para el alquiler evitará que la familia sin hogar tenga un alto riesgo de inestabilidad en la vivienda.
